Technology bolsters Michigan's economy, ranking in the top 15 states for share of high-tech sector workforce and investing over \$2.5 billion in research and development funding for future innovation. Just under 10% of Michigan's workforce is employed in the tech industry and the state is home to several technology focused Fortune 500 companies. <sup>1</sup>
