Wyoming employs 392 tech workers per billion of GSP and roughly eight percent of the state's total workforce is tech focused.¹ Wyoming is home to a strong clean energy sector, ranking in the top 20 states for highest share of power generated by renewables and employing a workforce of 500 in the sector alone.²
