Florida outputs a whopping \$47.96 billion in GDP from the information technology sector each year¹ and ranks in the top 20 states for high-tech sector workers.² Florida is home to three major tech focused Fortune 500 companies and the state invested nearly \$4 billion in research and development funding last year.³
