Georgia boasts an incredible \$52.06 billion in GDP output from the information technology sector¹ and is home to several major tech focused Fortune 500 companies. Georgia falls in the top 15 of states with the highest share of tech workers as over 10% of all jobs are technology focused.² Atlanta is also a growing tech hub and was ranked the 8th metro-area in the country for tech talent.³
