## The Tech Industry's Impact in Illinois:



Illinois has the 5th largest economy in the U.S. <sup>1</sup> and the information technology sector represents \$34.6 billion in annual GDP.<sup>2</sup> The state is home to 34 Fortune 500 companies <sup>3</sup> yet Chicago, while a growing tech hub, only represents about 10% of the state's total tech workforce.<sup>4</sup> Illinois averages over \$4.5 billion in research and development funding, suggesting strong STEM sector growth will continue over the next decade.<sup>5</sup> STEMrelated jobs in the state have grown by 3.5% annually since 2010, compared to 2.5% growth nationally.<sup>6</sup> And thanks to more than 300 corporate research facilities in the Chicago-area, state businesses conduct roughly \$12 billion in R&D activities annually.<sup>7</sup>
