Maine's focus on seven technology sectors¹ has helped it grow to a notable \$1.3 billion in GDP from the information technology sector.² The state continues to see significant growth in its biotech, environmental tech, marine tech and precision manufacturing sectors.³ Maine is also a leader in renewable energy, ranking in the top 20 for wind power production.⁴
