Minnesota outputs an impressive \$13.5 billion in GDP from the information technology sector and ranks in the top 10 states for share of high-tech sector¹ workforce.² The state is home to several tech focused Fortune 500 companies and just under 11% of the state's total workforce is employed in the technology sector.³
