Mississippi outputs nearly \$3 billion in GDP from the information technology sector¹ and more than five percent of the state's workforce is employed in the tech industry.² Jackson alone is home to roughly 5,000 computer and math related jobs³ and the city is investing in tech facilities for new and established businesses.⁴
