Nebraska outputs nearly \$4.5 billion in GDP from the information technology sector ¹ and ranks in the top 15 states for most tech jobs per capita, ahead of Texas and New York. ² Eight percent of the state's workforce is employed in the tech sector and Nebraska invests over half a billion dollars into research and development funding, ensuring a strong future for innovation in the state. ³
